

Privacy Policy

INTRODUCTION

Inify Laboratories AB (the "Company") is the controller of personal data for the processing of your personal data related to our digital channels and our products, offers, functions, tools, services, etc. (the "Service") and is therefore responsible to ensure that all personal data is processed in a correct manner and in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

This Privacy Policy (hereinafter the "Privacy Policy") describes the Company's processing of your personal data and has the purpose of ensuring that the Company, in its capacity as controller of personal data, processes information about you in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

Personal data means all types of information which can, directly or indirectly, be associated with a natural person. In the context of the Company's business personal data refers to given names and surnames, telephone numbers, addresses, postal codes and e-mail addresses (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Personal Data").

PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The Company processes your personal data e.g. if you are contact person at a supplier, customer or a partner or if you in any way have shown an interest in the Company and/or its business.

The personal data that we process may include name, contact information, and information about your profession. If you apply for work at the Company, we will also process such personal data that has been provided by you or that we might collect after having been in contact with you. We also process online identifiers such as IP addresses, MAC addresses or equivalent.

We may process your personal data in order to enter into and fulfil agreements with your employer and to send you relevant information about the Company and its products and services, such as newsletters. We might also process your personal data for hiring purposes. We process your data based on the legitimate interests of concluding business with the clients and business partners you represent, for direct marketing of our products and services as well as recruitment of staff.

The Company may share your personal data with other companies within the same company group or companies with similar products or services.

If the Company transfers your personal data to a recipient outside of the EU/EEA, the Company will take appropriate safeguards, to ensure your rights and freedoms, such as entering into standard data protection contracts.

Personal data will be stored for the duration of the relevant contract entered into, other commitments to you or your employer or as long as legal claims can be exercised and thereafter up to 10 years in addition to the current year with regard to statutory limitation. Personal data processed for hiring purposes may be stored for up to 2 years in addition to the current year for the legitimate interest of maintaining documentation , should the Company face any discrimination claims, or to be able to contact you with any future job opportunities if you have consented. Personal Data processed for marketing and newsletters will be processed until you unsubscribe.



YOUR RIGHTS AS A DATA SUBJECT

You have the right to:

- request information about the Personal Data concerning you that we process, as well as a copy of it;
- have incorrect Personal Data rectified and you can under certain circumstances have your Personal Data erased;
- oppose against certain processing of your Personal Data and request that the processing is restricted.
- have your Personal Data transferred to another controller (right to data portability), and
- if you are unsatisfied with our processing of your Personal Data, report our processing to the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection or any other local supervising authority.

If our processing of your Personal Data is based on consent you may withdraw your consent at any time by using the contact information below. Please note that this does not affect the legality of processing that has taken place before your withdrawal.

You may at any time via the contact information below obtain, erase or restrict the processing of your Personal Data. Please notice that if we restrict the processing of or erase your Personal Data we might not be able to provide the Service to you.

PROTECTION OF THE PERSONAL DATA

The Company has undertaken appropriate technical and organisational measures in order to protect Personal Data against loss, abuse, unauthorized access, revealing, alteration and destruction.

Company employees and suppliers are bound by confidentiality agreements and are obligated to follow the Company's rules for information and IT security, this Privacy Policy and other internal rules and policies which regulate the processing of Personal Data.

AMENDMENTS TO THE PRIVACY POLICY

The Company retains the right to amend this Privacy Policy as the Company sees fit. The date for the latest amendment is indicated at the end of this Privacy Policy. If the Company amends this Privacy Policy the Company will update on the web page. You are therefore recommended to read this Privacy Policy regularly in order to be updated on any amendments.
